Questions and Answers

Q How easy will it be to see the review date of a resource? Will this be displayed at the top of the resource information, so that users can see what is about to expire?

A We recognise the review date is important to users so they can have trust in the resource. Information that is displayed on resources will be taken to users as part of our user research. The decision on where and how the information will be displayed will come out of that user research to ensure it fits with users' requirements.

Q If we have multiple resources (eg Word, PDF, video) that we want to use together as a course, how will this work?

A We have started a big piece of work around content structure to ensure the agreed solution will be suitable for content from the other systems that will migrate to the Learning Hub e.g. e-Learning for Healthcare content. There will be the ability to add resources within courses to the Learning Hub.

Q Will there be "landing pages" for specific resources? e.g. view all resources from eWIN?

A We will be providing a "deep linking" feature meaning that users will be able to share and use a specific link to directly access a course or resource, for example. There will also be the ability for users to review all resources from a particular provider.

Q Is the forum the same as a community of practice?

A Forums will be a way for communities of practice to discuss and collaborate. The Learning Hub will enable discussions around specific resources but there will also be the opportunity to interact on a specific subjects or areas of interest.
