

# **Learning Hub Roadmap**

## For release up to end of Q4 2021/22

- With the catalogue content structure feature, owners of learning catalogues will be able to structure packages of learning material into logical folders and sub-folders to organise the resources within. This will help users follow a learning pathway which has been curated by the content provider. Users will be able to browse the folder structure and launch resources appropriate to the stage of learning they have reached.
- A new resource player will enable users to launch elearning packages hosted on the Learning Hub. This resource player is a feature common to many learning management systems and represents a significant milestone for the platform. Users will be able to upload, access and run elearning content from a wide range of different providers including nationally recognised professional bodies.

### In design and development, for release O1 2022/23

- Bookmarks will provide learners with a way to keep track
  of resources and catalogues for easy access in one place. Learners
  can store resources and catalogues in their own folder structure
  and come back to them at any time.
- A new **in-progress tray** on the homepage will provide learners with a way to see all the resources they currently have in progress, but have not completed.
- The Universal Access feature will broaden the range of people connected with the health and care sector to register to use the platform, allowing a wider range of users to access the Learning Hub. Content providers will be able to control which elements of their content will be available for access and use by this broader audience
- The **event resource** is a new category type which will offer the ability to create an event with a date and time, an attendee list, a waitlist, a simple post event survey and attachments and links. This will include the use of virtual classroom resources enabling event organisers to provide links to Microsoft Teams and Zoom virtual events.
- The new user profile feature will empower users of the Learning Hub to manage their profile details, including updating their registered email address.
- An additional range of features to enhance the learning experience will be added, these elements will include new ways to browse detailed images for visually focused learning methods and enhancements to 'cases', a feature which assists content curators to offer particular tailored learning opportunities.

#### **Future**

- Certificates Contributors can design and attach a certificate
  to a resource or course which, on completion or matching of rules
  defined in learning logic, will be provided to a learner. This will
  include a function for other users to validate that the certificate
  is authentic.
- Courses Resources and a folder structure can be created within
  a course of learning. A course can have its own branding,
  contain all the resource types and have learning logic assigned
  to create paths through the course to guide the learner based
  on results achieved.
- Homepage trays These will be added to show recommended learning based on a learner's profile.
- My Learning in progress This feature will show all the resources and courses that a learner has progressed
- Other users accessed this resource When displaying a resource, statistics for how often the resource has been accessed and completed by other learners will be displayed to will help learners gauge the popularity and usefulness of the resource.
- Related and suggested search results When displaying a resource, additional suggested resources will be displayed alongside. Within search results, other suggestions will be displayed for the learner to find related content.
- Transfer ownership of a resource A contributor, or catalogue editor, will be able to transfer resources from one contributor to another.
